EU INFORMATION EVENT

An EU Information Event for Kyushu University students was held at Oumei Cohi Kan, Kyushu University, under the cooperation of the Kyushu University EU Centre and Kyushu University Self-Access Learning Centre (SALC). Approximately 20 students gathered. The EU Study Diploma Programmes (EU-DPs), which are provided as an axis of the EU Centre's educational activities for Kyushu University students, along with various events being planned as JMCoE-Q activities for the coming years, such as seminars, EU Studies tour, and EU Studies Summer Course, were introduced.

Prof. Hiroshi Ohashi, Director of SALC, Faculty of Arts and Science, stated that he was pleased to have such an event held on-campus to gather students who are keenly interested in international relations, studying abroad, and language improvement. He also stated that he was looking forward to further fosterage of collaborative relationships.

Prof. Kenji Iwata, Director of the Kyushu University EU Centre, Faculty of Economics, gave a lecture for around 15 minutes about the UK'S Separation from the EU, titled "Brexit Mini Lecture", which covered a basic explanation of EU institutions for students unfamiliar with the EU.

Ms Lyailya Nurgaliyeva from the Republic of Kazakhstan, who is currently working at SALC as a language coaching staff and had completed the EU-DPs course, spoke about her own experiences of learning about the EU through EU-DPs. She explained that the EU-DPs are not only useful for gaining knowledge, but also as a key to opening the door to realizing a dream. She encouraged the participants to learn more through the EU-DPs course.

Finally, Mr Hijiri Miyazaki, a fourth-year student of the School of Engineering, Kyushu University, talked about his personal experience at the EU Studies Residential Summer Course. He is working as a director of the Student Committee for the Internationalization of Kyushu University (SCIKyu), which is an official committee comprised of Japanese students, international students, and some teaching and non-teaching staff members, whose aim is to help foster the internationalization of Kyushu University. He explained that he learned a lot through the curriculum of the summer course in which participants could learn general and basic knowledge about the EU, covering topics such as economics, law, politics, society, and culture. He emphasized that the final program, a "Simulation of the European Council", was meaningful as a compilation of the programme. Mr Miyazaki also explained the aims and activities of SCIKyu.

Traditional Italian sweets served in the Christmas season, called *panettone*, were served with coffee, and the event ended in a relaxed atmosphere.
