

Privacy Policy for Participants of an Event, Conference, Meeting, Program, Seminar and/or Lectures (online or on site) held, organized and provided by EU Centre of Kyushu University

This Privacy Policy describes how and why National University Corporation Kyushu University (hereinafter referred to as “KU” or “we”) through its EU Centre collects, uses and stores your personal data and your rights in relation to the personal data KU holds. 1. The personal data we collect

The personal data KU collects from you is as following:

- Personal contact details: your name, home address, email address, and phone number;
- Personal details: date of birth, gender, nationality/citizenship, and photograph;
- Profile data including your enquiries, specific requests, preferences, feedback, and survey responses that you provide to KU;
- Contact details about your family as part of the participation process, and next of kin or guardian in the event of emergency;
- Other data or information about you which have been generated during your

time at KU (participation of an event or program), and data on how you access or use KU's resources (library, websites, virtual, learning environments);

- Information about your bank accounts details * ;
- Information about your academic transcript (Grade Point Average Score) * ;
- Information about your language learning history * ; and
- Data or information related to Study abroad insurance * .

Note: Personal data marked with “ * ” symbols in the sentence above may be collected from those who applies to participate in a special program provided by KU as necessary.

2. How KU collect your personal data

The personal data we will collect is directly from you or when you:

- submit the application documents by e-mail, post or hand in;
- request or enquire any KU information to be sent to you;
- complete the online application forms;
- access any web account on KU's platforms;
- register for an event-conference, seminar, workshops or visit KU campus;
- participate in an event-conference, seminar, workshops or other program held, planed and/or provided by KU;

- request additional services such as transportation, visa assistant or accommodation;
- provide your personal data online; or
- provide your personal to the other parties such as consultants or official organizational representatives.

3. How KU use your personal data

We process your personal data for the lawful base which is a contractual obligation or steps on your part to enter into a contract with KU-based on your request to participate an event, seminar, conference and other program organized and provided by KU. For fulfilling this respect, we use your personal data for the following:

- to provide our conference service, IT information and other conference (program) related service to you;
- to deal with any concerns or feedback you may have;
- to provide you further information regarding the event, seminar and program organized by KU;
- to administer financial documents, statements and receipts;
- to remit scholarship to your bank account;
- to ensure your and participant safety and security;

- to process your personal data for other purposes for which you provide it to us; and
- to evaluate and monitor the performance and effectiveness of KU.

We may also process your personal data in relation to compliance with our legal obligations and our missions. For fulfilling this respect, we may use your personal data for the following:

- financial audits;
- compliance with our regulatory and legal obligation; and
- prevention and detection of crime.

If you access certain optional services, we will ask for your consent for data processing.

We may process your personal data because it is necessary for our legitimate interests. In this respect, we may use your personal data for the following:

- to maintain and improve academic, educational and research ability, and financial and human resource management of KU;
- to promote equality, diversity and research integrity; and
- to monitor compliance with KU's rules and regulations.

4. Sharing your personal data with third parties

Your personal data may be shared with the following types of relevant public authorities:

- Ministry of Education Culture, Sports, Science and Technology;

- Immigration Bureau, Ministry of Justice;
- Japan Society For the Promotion of Science; and/or
- EU related public authorities.

If we want to use your personal data for a reason other than those purposes set out above, or transfer your personal data to any other third parties, you will be notified and asked for consent.

5. How long we keep your personal data

Your personal data we collected either through the application process or directly from you, will only be kept for a period, that is set base on the legal requirements of the national and local authorities in Japan.

6. Your rights

Once your personal data has been collected, you have the right:

- to request an access to your personal data that we hold;
- to rectify or erasure your personal data;
- to restrict or object to processing your personal data;
- to ask for a copy of your personal data in a format that allows easy transfer (“data portability”); and

· to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness processing based on consent before this withdrawal.

7. Cookies* policy:

We will use cookies to collect some personal data when you browse our website.

The personal data collected by cookies will only be used for our services mentioned above.

We also use cookies to deliver our services (including, but not limited to, “Application Form” and “Language Setting”, and “Survey”) and targeted advertising based on your use of our web site.

Advertising technologies which may set cookies on our site including, but not limited to, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube and others.

We also use Google Analytics and Adobe Analytics and others to collect information on how visitors use our site.
